

Rules:

- There will be 4 categories for judging: grades K-5, 6-8, 9-12 and Adults.
- Poems cannot be over thirty-two (32) lines of text. Title does not count as a line.
- Poems may be in any genre and on any appropriate subject; i.e., no pro-violence, pro-drugs, etc.
- Poems containing language that is vulgar, offensive, or wholly inappropriate will not be accepted.
- All entries must be in English and be the original work of the entrant.
- Poems must not have been published anywhere prior to contest.
- Poems must avoid using "texting" lingo and all words must be spelled out.
- All poems must be neatly typed or hand printed and titled.
- You may submit up to three (3) poems.
- Email submissions will be accepted in the form of a Word document.
- Submit poem without your name on it for anonymous judging. Be sure title of poem is on entry form.
- Send only a copy of your poem; submissions will not be returned.
